Minutes of the Meeting

Min 5186

There were declaration from all councillors that they were members of Trimsaran Village forum but that was on a personal and not a prejudicious nature. Minutes of the AGM 24th.May 2021 meeting were read and unanimously resolved to be a true record.

Min 5187 Minutes Arising

1. Zip wire – KB speaking to playground maintenance team and they confirmed that they will price rubber matting to be placed under the zip wire run. There was an issue with the seating on the zip wire but that was rectified in the same day , bolts on the stop ends of the zip wire have been replaced.
2. Two ton of bark been placed in the play area
3. Play ground inspection last week but no report received back as yet.
4. PCSO been up to the leisure centre and informed that they will be doing drop in sessions with the community.
5. Leisure centre open 9-3 Mon to Friday, Cafe doing slow trade.
6. Police are patrolling school in light of the complaints regarding car parking outside the school during drop off and pick up times and they are working with the Head and parents to improve the situation
7. Dr Surgery to open at the leisure centre from the 5th. July

Min 5189 County Councillors Report

1. Issue with zip wire and general maintenance in the park
2. Fly tipping and over grown hedges are an issue
3. Hedge cutting limited to areas displaying traffic signs
4. Lottery application for youth worker and luncheon club it is hoped that the youth worker can continue for another year.
5. Sally Bonnell application on MUGA- received information back from Lottery stating 1 in 10 are successful in their application and takes about three months to receive a decision.
6. Been approached by parents saying that they have been informed by a particular individual that they should approach the council and insist that play equipment be

purchased, KB explained that situation regarding the precept and that it's not as high as neighbouring authorities, agreed that the play area needs upgrading and that funding would be looked at and has invited Community group parents to the councils next meeting to discuss the matter.

7. Litter picking – Mr Dan Smyth informed that bags for litter picking will only be supplies to groups that have insurance, Tidy Trim group have now insured pro rata up to February 2022, Health and safety restricts groups to thirty people to pick and that all litter bags be numbered due to misuse, it is hoped that this will be a monthly event and that the first will be held on the 11July at 10 am until 12 noon all to meet at the leisure centre.

During discussion it was suggested that one or two Christmas trees be purchased and possible sponsored be approached the trees to be located at Trilwm and the Leisure centre. Alma Davies to make the necessary enquires and report findings by next community council meeting.

Final bill for the Leisure centre is being discussed with the contractor before its conclusion there will be additional cost incurred due to additional work carried out and estimations on material and labour cost higher than expected.

It was discussed and agreed by all the councillors in attendance to purchase ten hanging baskets this year.

7(e) on the agenda

County Councillor Kim Broom apologised for the incorrect name on the agenda it should have read Tabernacle Chapel, mistake arose by her receiving incorrect Chapel name.

It had been brought to County Councillor Kim Broom attention that the Chapel was up for sale and its possibilities are discussed regarding its purchase and that the matter is discussed by council. After some discussion on the matter regarding the possibilities for the building it was agreed not to purchase the Chapel. During the discussion it came to light that there was a legal duty to keep the gravestones and that only the Chapel building was up for sale.
