

## **TRIMSARAN COMMUNITY COUNCIL Meeting November 22<sup>nd</sup>.2021**

### **Minutes of the Meeting**

### **Min 5228**

County Councillor Kim Broom welcomed Joanna Leeuwerke to the meeting and asked the councillors in attendance if Joanna could introduce herself and give an outlay of what her organisation offer before carrying on with the agenda.

### **Min 5229**

#### **7 (g) on the agenda**

Joanna gave a background on Threshold DAS , “Threshold DAS (formerly Llanelli Women’s Aid Ltd) was founded in 1984, by a group of volunteers an organisation committed to the elimination of violence and abuse of women, men, children and young people and those who are perpetrators through effecting political, cultural, and social change”

Joanna then discussed what the organisation offered in the way of training , DAS offered two training programs an over 18 but under the age of 25 currently in full time /part time work and live in the Blaenau Gwent, Caerphilly, Carmarthenshire or Pembrokeshire area.

The other being over 25 being unemployed for twelve months or more or economically inactive, some of the subjects covered in the training are personal confidence, environmental awareness and mental health and stress.

The project is supported by the European Social Fund through the WCVA’s Active Inclusion programme, the training programme would be over a six week period one evening a week, originally face to face but since the pandemic is now on line but hoping to return to a face to face in the near future.

Joanna then asked if there were any upcoming events that she could attend or organisations within the village that she could contact to discuss the project with.

Joanna was then given a date of the 4<sup>th</sup>. December for the Christmas fayre and told to contact the Leisure centre manager to make arrangements, Bobol Bach and flying start were given as possible contacts.

Joanna then left brochures to be displayed on the notice board; she thanked the council for their time and left the meeting at 18:49hrs
