3. Three litter bins have been allocated around the village (Argoed, Coal Yard and Arlan Morlais) the County Council have agreed to empty the bins.
4. Speed sign has been replaced at Pen y Mynydd
5. Fly tipping had been reported after the sevens tournament and enforcement action was taken against the team.
6. Picnic site (Lookout) has had maintenance taken place.
7. It is proposed that Bt broadband get incorporated into the Leisure Centre running cost.
8. Data Protection – new legislation has taken affect
9. Argoed- issue with porta cabin placed on site the incident has been reported to County.
10. LDP – end of August eco-survey required on land
11. Refuse site located at the old rugby club has some issues to resolve.
