Min5783 Community Councillors Report

1. County Council authority will be voting on finalising the budget which is expected to be in the region of 4.9%
2. Damaged bollard by park has been removed and the hole covered by tarmac.
3. Residence have been asking about bus routes to Kidwelly and the reinstatement of the bus to Waun y Clun.
4. There has been development regarding the closure of Pontyates doctors' surgery and the effects it will have on Kidwelly and Trimsaran surgeries.
5. Footpath near picnic area on mountain road due to the recent heavy rain there has been a land slip, I have asked the clerk to report the incident to county.
6. Received complaints from a resident regarding the recent installation of bollards located by the bridge which restricts his moments in and out of his property.
7. There have been some housing issues
8. Anti-social behaviour has improved, and the youth club has returned.
9. Removal of the skate ramps have started with the first one being removed for repair last week.
10. Old Hall – Contractor has highlighted issues with the support to the roof structure (non-existent), a structural engineer has been employed to look at solutions to the problem. It is still hoped to complete by the end of June.

Site: **Lon Ffos Las, Trimsaran, Kidwelly**

Development: **A One Planet Development which consists of a single dwelling and ancillary buildings. The land is currently used for agricultural and forestry purposes**
