Min 5791

Min 5792

Declaration from all councillors, that they were members of Trimsaran Village forum but that was on a personal and not prejudicial nature.

Min 5793 Matters Arising

1. Pontyates surgery – strong support locally there is a meeting on the 31st.March between 2-6 pm to voice opinion on the service
2. Clerk to chase landslip issue
3. There are fly tipping issues on Mountain Road
4. Anti-social behaviour within the village – Gwyn Price, coach windows being smashed, and youths on the roof of the old miners Hall.

1. Welsh Water have placed traffic lights at the roundabout at the entrance of the leisure centre.
2. Culla road – culvert could be Ffos Las problem (location of a possible blocked second drainage pipe)
3. There continues to be a speeding problem on Heol Llanelli (requested strips to be placed so monitoring can take place). It has been noticed that the volume of traffic passing through the village has also increased.
4. Complaints received regarding - Trilwm – Cae Linda building debris be dumped on plot at the top. Planning enforcement to be informed
5. Parking issues at Trilwm, Garden Suburbs, Heol Llanelli.
6. Sport and Social club applying for drinking licence and the renovation going well.
7. Purdah mindful to ensure that nothing political will be shared.

4. Suggestions made for the Council to consider looking at community-owned renewable energy and smart local energy systems (SLES).
