Min5819 Community Councillors Report

1. Housing issues this month with Anti-social behaviour with tenants
2. Water on Culla Road – work within Ffos Las did reduce the water level on the road.
3. Complaint email sent in by the Clerk last month regarding the work carried out on the bridle way – response from Carmarthenshire County enforcement team – surprised by the amount of work carried out and the matter will now be investigated, in line with their Enforcement Statement, to ascertain whether a breach of planning control has occurred. and it was now being taken up by the legal department.
4. Old Hall – youths climbed the scaffolding on the front refurbishment section and entered the roof space and attempted to set fire in the roof void - fire brigade attended and extinguished the fire, police as well as forensics have attended the scene.
5. Skate Park – as mentioned previously – back by end of the month.
6. Reported to highways the issue of the potholes within the village
7. Grand opening of the ONYELEN Football Club and Sport Bar on the 30th. May, all councillors invited.
8. Meeting of the Education scrutiny committee held last Tuesday approved a new location for Heol Goffa (SEN), the new location is located near Ysgol Pen Rhos and scheduled to open in September 2029.

Min 5820 Planning
